**GAMESTEC ROLLS OUT ITS FIRST 100 PARAGON TT MACHINES  
Operator is first to site sought-after product**

Following a successful trial, Gamestec are now installing 100 of the new Paragon TT machines from Games Warehouse. Ten of the new SWP terminals have already been installed with the remaining 90 to be rolled out over the next few weeks.

Gamestec will be the first operator to install Paragon TT in substantial volumes and this move underlines the company's commitment to a "best of breed" product strategy.

New features of the TT model include a high resolution 22-inch 16:10 aspect ratio LCD monitor and a scratch resistant touch screen. Security has also been improved with multi-point locking on both doors and an integrated locking bar system.
